FIRE AT GEOCYCLE PLANT – DANDENONG

A small fire occurred at Cement Australia's wholly-owned Geocycle plant in Dandenong, Victoria, late last night. The fire, contained to the plant's waste ink storage area, was immediately extinguished by the Country Fire Authority who attended the scene. There is no risk to nearby areas and no injuries were sustained by anyone at the scene.

The Environment Protection Authority attended the scene this morning and is comfortable that no environmental risk exist as a result of the fire. The Country Fire Authority, Victorian Workcover Authority and The City of Greater Dandenong have all completed their investigations and will not be taking further action.

Damage to the site is minimal with no impact to the broader business. Operations at the site have resumed as normal.

Geocycle offers industry a sustainable solution to the problem of industrial by-products disposal by utilising recycled by-products as both raw materials replacement and as an alternative source of fuel in the cement making process. Geocycle's current operations include the processing of solvent based fuels and the processing of spent cell liners and other carbon materials from the aluminium industry.
